On 6.4.2010 there was a discussion about Africa organised by Markéta Zlá and David Švejnoha. The tutors described by authentic talking, a documentary film, photos and workshops to the pupils of 6.-9. years the different life standard in our country and in Africa, but also the contrast of rich and poor in Africa.

Pupils were captured by the talk. They positively appreciated the chance to practise using the scarf and carrying the baby similarly to women in Africa. Thanks to the documentary they could imagine present Africa and life of local people. Especially the part of the documentary showing the talk of a young girl, who had to undergo female mutilation or the children living in the street sniffing glue, it was a strong emotional experience for our pupils that evoked a discussion even days after the discussion. We really enjoyed the workshops focused on production of toys from the rubbish and making masks. Some of us also appreciated the possibility to create the alphabet for pupils in Africa. Our pupils realised that due to the poverty they do not get things we take for granted.

We thank to the tutors for the discussion and we evaluate the event as very successful, children could learn more about situation in Africa and the fact that they are not inattentive to life of children in Africa they want to express by support of adoption for distance and some classes are interested in cooperation with a school in Africa.

Primary school Hostýnská in Prague 10 and Community Centre Kruh at ZŠ Hostýnská prepared in cooperation with Humanist Centre Narovinu, o.s. **Month in Africa**. The event has been arranged for the fourth time at our school during April 2010. Month in Africa was one of the possibilities to support education of children in Africa by a collection of school supplies.

Children from our school took part in an **official collection of school supplies** during the month. They have brought exercise book, pencils, crayons, sheets of paper, books.

On Wednesday 28.4.2010 during the morning in cooperation with Humanist Centre Narovinu o.s. there was **a discussion and a slide show for children of the 5th classes of our school**. At the presentation, children got a lot of information about life in Kenya and also about the way to help children from this country. They had a chance to meet coordinators from Kenya directly. This meeting was very beneficial for children, for someone it was the very first meeting with a person of different colour and culture. After the discussion there was a festive handover of produced and chosen presents to African children to the representatives of Humanist Centre, who organised transfer to children in need. Visitor could have a look and buy small products directly from Kenya.

In 2007, the school took a patronage over one of African pupils and supported him during his next studies. The money collection happened at the end of the school year and we were able to collect money that could cover one year of studies in Kenya of the boy called Elijah.

The cooperation with Humanist Centre Narovinu, o.p.s. was very nice and helpful. We included the project "Adoption for Distance" to our own project of development of Community Centre and we hope it will continue in the future.

Albert Hotový, the director of the school contributes: "We hope, children and public enjoyed "Month in Africa", that we were successful in contribution of our products and financial help to a good purpose. Children learnt to cooperate and support the weak and they enjoyed an exotic week at school also with their parents. The part of the project was also an exhibition of photos from Kenya in the entrance hall of school, open to public. The photos were lent by Humanist Centre Narovinu o.p.s."
