The project of long-distance adoption of African children has helped over 3,5 thousand children.

It all started in 2007, when the family Pavelka from Bratislava read a following story on the internet:

"Eunice Akinyi was born on 12. 8. 1996. Eunica's parents died when she was little. Since then, she has been looked after by her aunt Evarline Adhiambo. Eunice has no siblings. They live in a thatch house. They use wood for cooking, oil lamp for lighting, and they use water from the river. Evarline is a farmer. Eunice likes to play football and volleyball..."

Fulfilled Wish

Today, Eunice is 17 years old and she is attending high school thanks to the program "Adoption of African Children – project of long-distance help". She would like to become a nurse and help people in Kenya. The family Pavelka has been supoporting her education since 2007." "Till 2011 we only exchanged letters and packages," says Eva Pavelková. "In one letter, Eunice wrote that she keeps a hen and her brother keeps a bunny, and if we come visit them, they would like to give them to us. It's hard to describe how it made me feel but my reaction was surprising both for me and for my close ones: I am going to Africa!" And it really happened. The same year, the family Pavelka spent a week with Eunice in Siaya, Kenya. "The welcome was really warm, full of emmotions and personal contact, as if we were a real family," continues Pavelková." We lived with them, tried to work with them, cooked, and enjoyed each other's company. Even though it was holidays, the representatives of Malomba School made time to meet with us and we gave them teaching aids which we brought with us." During the visit, the Pavelka family and Eunice promised each other, that one day Eunice would visit them in Slovakia... Their wish came true at the end of last year when Eunice spent Christmas and New Year's Eve with her Slovakian family. Besides Bratislava, she visited Christmas Vienna and also Prague.

Education and Health Care

The program of long-distance adopion is a project of Centre Narovinu, a non-governmental organization. Since 2002 they have been able to help over 3.5 thousand children. Centre Narovinu focuses on global development cooperation and aims at improving education, health care and overall quality of life in Arica. Among their main activities are projects of global development cooperation in Kenya and global development education programs in the Czech and Slovakian Republic. Education in Kenya can be supported, besides the program of adoption, also irregularly, for example through a gift certificate "Pass i on!" (200 Kč for a school bag, 300 Kč for school tools, 1000 or 3000 Kč for tuition). Through the program "Give Health", it is possible to donate high quality health care in the following areas: treatment of common illnesses (200 Kč), specialized examination (400 Kč), childbirth (600 Kč), treatment of broken bones or dog bites (1 800 Kč) (More about Centre Narovinu and its programs can be found on the website http://www.centrumnarovinu.cz.)





Czech People Like the Project of Long-distance Adoption, They Help African Children with Education

People in the Czech Republic showed interest in the project of long-distance adoption. Thanks to Centre Narovinu, more than 2 000 children in African Kenya gained access to education. Without their financial help, they could not afford going to school.

Long- distance adoptions help children from the poorest African families with getting education which they usually cannot afford by themselves. In practice, the adopted children stay living with their families while the tuition and other school-related expanses are covered by the "adoptive parents"



from Europe. It can be an individual or a group of people, a family or even a school. The organization Centre Narovinu, which specializes in helping families in Kenya, has provided access to education for more than 2000 thousand children. "The amount of money necessary to cover tuition and other school expanses is about 7 200 Kč for elementary schools and 14 400 Kč for high schools since it also covers accommodation and food," says Simona Heřtusová from Centre Narovinu. Money is not sent to the children's families, but directly to schools or local coordinators, who cooperate with local charitable organizations. Adoptive parents get information about the children's school results on regular basis. They also usually exchange photographs or write each other letters. The condition is for the parents to adopt a child for the minimum period of 1 year.

An 18 year old Helen from Kenya just came to visit her adoptive parents in the Czech Republic. "The journey was great, I am really happy," said Helen shortly after her arrival. It was her first journey outside of Kenya but she travelled without any problems. She even managed to transfer successfully at the big international airport in Zurich. Her adoptive parents, Pavel and Jarmila from Liberec, that have been supporting Helen since she was five, were really excited to meet her. "We want her to experience and participate in our everyday life," said the parents.

An Easter fair took place in the courtyard of the monastery. It offered variety of Easter products as well entertainment for children. They could ride a pony or have their face painted. One of the most visited stands was the one with products made by pupils from the local elementary school which served a good purpose - the proceeds were used to support the education of a 14 year old girl in Kenya. "The girl's name is Muthinu Munywuki. Through the project of long-distance adoption we cover her tuition (school books and a uniform) and we even send her little extra gifts. We have been doing so since 2007. We sell pupils' products Nicholas'day, at Easter and historical markets. Our pupils really enjoy the markets and they love making the products for sale," says their teacher Bohuslava Dusíková and adds that the pupils always look forward to letters from Kenya which often include a photograph or a drawing.

Meeting Teachers from Island of Hope Haló noviny online



Two Kenyan teachers Kevin Okinyi Onyango and Vincent Onyango Rowa work with pupils at the elementary school in the community centre Island of Hope on Rusinga Island. The project started in 2003 and it has been running successfully also thanks to Czech and Slovakian sponsors that support the children through the project of "Adoption of African children- project of long-distance help".

What is their experience with implementing innovative teaching methods? What are the reactions of the pupils, their parents and the community? Was the school and its students successful in the state-wide ratings?

The teachers will provide adoptive parents, who have been supporting the children from the Island of Hope, with information about their adopted children. They will inspire others. Come and meet Kevin and Vincent who teach Kenyan children and thus provide them with the chance of a better life.

After the Tuesday lecture in Prague 10 Vršovice, another one will be held on Saturday May 9th between 17 - 18.30 in Kutná Hora in a Cafe Na Kozím Plácku (Dačické Square 10) and on Monday May 11th at the same time in Ostrava in the restaurant Credo (Pavlovova 135/44, Ostrava-Zábřeh).


The teachers were invited to the Czech Republic by the partner school Park Lane, which offered them consultations and personal experience with teaching in their Prague school. Also, they will have a chance to attend an international seminar for teachers, which is organized for the Park Lane teachers on regular basis.

Island of Hope is a project of Centre Narovinu, a non-governmental organization, which was founded in 1995. Center Narovinu mainly focuses on the projects of global development cooperation, global development education, and the development of volunteer work. They have been organizing projects in African Kenya since year 2000.

In all their activities, they emphasize sustainability, self- sufficiency and active responsibility. The main projects of Center Narovinu are: "Adoption of Africant Children – project of long-distance help", "Africa Through Unusual Eyes – programs at schools for public", and the community centre "Island of Hope" on Rusinga Island in Kenya.

The Movie Theater in Cáslav Offers Two Experiences

The culture lovers in Čáslav are used to the fact, the when they enter the Dusíkovo theater they are welcome by different short-term art exhibitions. At the moment, they can enjoy the works of amateur



photographers from Čáslav. Ocassionally, exhibitions also take place at the movie theater of Miloš Forman. It currently displays interesting photos documenting ordinary days of life in Kenya.

The exhibition is called "Karibuni Kenya -Africa Through Uncummon Eyes" and it is organized by Centre Narovinu, which is an organization that deals with the possibilities of development cooperation with people living in this African country. Their aim is to improve the conditions for getting education education, to provide health care and other things which we usually take for granted here. Currently, Centre Narovinu organizes a project of long-distance adoption and it runns a community centre Island of Hope with an orphanage and educational center for children on Rusinga Island in Lake Victoria.

Another project of Centre Narovinu is "Water for Kauti" the aim of which is to provide acess to water and improve its purity which significantly increase agricultural production that directly affects the averall quality of life of the local community. "Our exhibition travells from place to place," explains Simona Heřtusová, the President of the administration board of the centre who also works as a project coordinator.

"Through the exhibition, we try to broaden the horizons of Czech people and show them what life in Kenya is like. But we don't want to show only photos of horror and dispair. Attentive audience can notice the child's smile on the background of usually a very bad family situation. We have been going to Kenya since 2001 and we have personally encountered a number of tragical events. Which is why we decided to start helping," explains Simona Heřtusová.

All the visitors and anybody else who is interested can join in the activities of Centre Narovinu and help either financially or in a different way (for example by promoting the organization). More information can be found at <u>www.centrumnarovinu.cz</u>. The exhibition will be at display till the end of April at the movie theater of Miloš Forman either before the individual screenings or upon agreement with the head of the cultural institution.
